#### **1. F.6 Graduation Ceremony**

The originally scheduled graduation ceremony for Form 6 students on 13<sup>th</sup> March 2024 (Wednesday) will be moved forward to 12<sup>th</sup> March (Tuesday) in the morning, to be held in our school hall. Parents of Form 6 students are welcome to attend the ceremony. Please complete the electronic registration form through the link provided on the school website and submit it by 5<sup>th</sup> March (Tuesday). For details, please contact the class teachers. #### **2. Study Leave and HKDSE Examinations for Form 6 Students**

- (2) From 8<sup>th</sup> March (Friday) to 11<sup>th</sup> March (Monday), it will be a day for discussing the mock examination papers, and students are required to attend classes according to the regular timetable. Starting from March 13<sup>th</sup> (Wednesday), students are not required to attend classes and should stay at home to study diligently and focus on preparing for the public examinations. To assist students in preparing for the public examinations, teachers will arrange revision classes for students. The makeup class timetable will be distributed to students later. Students must wear their school uniforms neatly and attend classes punctually. If students choose to study at school, they must also wear their school uniforms and enter and exit the school gate according to the normal school hours.
- (3) Form 6 students can return to school from 26<sup>th</sup> April (Friday) onwards to collect their annual result slips, graduation certificates, and other documents from their class teachers. Please keep these documents properly.
- (4) The HKDSE will be held from late March to May. Candidates must arrive at the designated examination venues stated on their admission cards on time. 17<sup>th</sup> July (Wednesday) is the release day of the 2024 HKDSE results. All Form 6 students must come to school at 8:30 am to collect their HKDSE result notifications.

#### **3. Ching Ming Festival and Easter Holiday**

The Ching Ming Festival and Easter Holiday will be from 29<sup>th</sup> March (Friday) to 7<sup>th</sup> April (Sunday). The first day of classes after the holiday will be on 8<sup>th</sup> April (Monday).
