Arrangement for Suspension of Face-to-face Classes

Our school was informed by the Centre for Health Protection this morning that because a parent of our student was a confirmed case of Covid-19 and this student was regarded as a close contact, our school has to suspend face-to-face classes and activities on campus until the start of Christmas holidays according to the instructions of the Centre for Health Protection. With regard to such face-to-face class suspension, our school will make the arrangement shown as follows:

1. First Term Exam, originally starting from 9th to 21st November 2020, will be postponed from 27th January 2020 to 8th February 2020; the S.6 Mock Exam in Mid-February will be cancelled. The First Term Exam will cover 50% of the S.1-5 annual assessment; whereas the Second Term Exam will cover its reminding 50%. First Term Exam will cover 100% of the S.6 annual assessment.
2. 2.1 All students need to attend the Class Teacher Period (via ZOOM) tomorrow (1st December), after which they should come back to school to get back their textbooks and teaching materials by the following groups:
 - S.1-2 11:00 - 11:30
 - S.3-4 11:30 - 12:00
 - S.5-6 12:00 - 12:30
- 2.2 All classes will be conducted according to the original timetable via ZOOM during the period from 2nd to 21st December.
(8:15 am to 1:30 pm)
The ZOOM ID and Password of every subject teacher will be disseminated via GRWTH.
3. All activities inside and outside school will be suspended, and S.6's 'Walk with Me' Program will be conducted via ZOOM.

The details of the above arrangements, together with others concerning student daily body temperature and disinfection measures after class resumption, will be disseminated and informed to students and parents via e-notice and SMS later. It is hoped that parents will encourage children to study hard and do not stop learning despite class suspension. Parents should also remind children to pay more attention to environmental and personal hygiene and avoid any crowded places to reduce the risk of infection. Our school will strengthen the work of environmental hygiene and disinfection for the protection of students and teachers.
