Dear S1-5 Parents,

Re: Lesson Arrangement after Easter Holidays

To provide more learning opportunities on campus, EDB announced on 26/3/2021 that school could let more students, up to less than 2/3 of total number of students, come back after Easter holidays according to its needs. Lesson time should be up to half day. Apart from that, to satisfy the needs of pandemic prevention, face-to-face lessons will be suspended from 26/4 to 3/5 to reserve the premises for the public exams. All students will follow the existing timetable for online lessons either in the morning or in the afternoon till 3/5/2021 in line with the EDB's suggestions.

2. Change of Summer School Uniform

Due to the gradual warming of the weather, the school plans to change the summer uniform from 8/4 (Thursday) to 23/4 (Friday) as the transition period. During the transition period, students can choose to wear summer or winter uniforms according to the weather conditions, but they must wear a full set of summer school uniforms or winter school uniforms. Starting from 4/5 (Tuesday), all students in the school must wear neat summer uniforms at school. Owing to the epidemic situation, students can wear sports uniforms (T-shirts + trousers) back to school on the day when there is a physical education class and avoid gathering in the changing room.

Students should prepare for face-to-face classes after the Easter holidays, continue to observe epidemic prevention measures, pay attention to personal hygiene, and avoid crowded places to reduce the risk of contracting diseases. We will keep paying attention to the epidemic development and posting up the latest arrangement on the school website and Growth in due course. Parents and students should pay heed and keep up with the latest information.
